If you have already registered for the BCS Conference, then you do not need to re-register again.

You must produce a poster to display continuously throughout the 3-day meeting. Each poster must be **non-fabric, A0 in size, 841mm (height) X 1189mm (width)** and should be in **landscape mode**. A conflict of interest statement must be clearly indicated on each poster. If you have no conflict of interest, please state '**No conflict of interest**'.

The posters need to be **secured on the appropriate board by 10:00am on Monday 2 June** and should **remain in position until closure of the Education Hall on Wednesday 4 June**. Posters should be fixed to the boards by the hook and loop (double sided Velcro) system which will be provided in an envelope for each individual poster and fixed to each poster board. No other fixtures are allowed.

You will be able to store your poster tube/container in the poster tube bins provided in the Education Hall.

You will be able to display your poster throughout the conference and have the chance to discuss your topic with colleagues during the breaks. **You are not required to attend your poster for any specific times**, but rather it will be available for all attendees to view throughout the conference.

The Education Hall and Poster Area closes at **4.15pm** on Wednesday afternoon. All posters remaining at this time will be taken down by BCS staff and will be available for collection from the organisers' office until **6.00pm**. Posters not collected after this time will be destroyed.
